- Clear application of an NBCC content area
- SMART learning objectives to the program (Specific, measurable, attainable, results-focused, time appropriate)
- Clinically sound content using the most recent research, principles, and techniques in accordance with the DSM 5
- Connection to the Building Health Relationships 2018 theme of building understanding with diverse groups of people
- Offering of new information not already presented at other professional development opportunities in South Dakota
- Information applicable to both school and mental health professionals

Call for Programs Criteria

Programs must comply with the NBCC's Approved Content Areas.

Primary presenters MUST hold an advanced degree in Counseling or a Counseling related field. Please email rachael.anderson@k12.sd.us with any questions.

Each presenter must furnish his/her own handouts free of charge and/or provide access, electronically (e.g., email attachment) or otherwise to participants.

Presentations and related materials such as handouts and their use must conform to the current ACA Ethical Code, especially those guidelines related to G.5. Publication (e.g., G.5.a. Use of Case Examples).
